

Volunteer and Leadership Club

Introduction

Volunteer and Leadership (V&L) is an innovative club designed to promote service values, fundraising and leadership opportunities for students in grades 6-16 with an initial focus on high school students. V&L is an inclusive club that delivers a step-by-step success-building program engaging all students regardless of specific interests, post-graduate goals or academic status. Our mission is to prepare V&L members for further learning – be it college or vocational training - and their ultimate workforce entry. In addition to acquiring skills outside the school core curriculum through on-line education and work apprenticeship programs, V&L students learn the value of service through active participation in charitable and community-oriented events. V&L works in partnership with our business members to develop student competencies in soft skills such as career planning, financial literacy, project management, marketing and sales, and more. Competencies, once earned, are acknowledged with Volunteer and Leadership's Micro-Credential badges. These Micro-Credentials become part of the student's resume, and strengthen the student's appeal to college admissions officers and future employers. V&L coordinated Business Partnership programs provide students "real-world" leadership, service, work skills, and fundraising opportunities, recognized with Micro-Credentials attesting to performance to established standards. V&L's alliance with our Business Partners provides a path that may ultimately lead students to CO-OP engagements and full-time positions immediately after graduation. To ensure success, Volunteer and Leadership highlights academic, service and business opportunities; coordinates student engagements; tracks each member's activities and accomplishments; and provides a written record of participation and achievement.

Product Overview

Leadership:

V&L events are led by student volunteers who are approved by V&L adult leaders. For student leaders, the Volunteer and Leadership platform offers checklists with step-by-step guidelines for the creation and coordination of events. The student leader will open a request for an event in the system that includes details, time, date, and location. Once complete, a form is presented to the student for electronic signature and transferred to the adult leader's inbox for approval. Once approved, the leader plans the event using the intuitive step-by-step checklist. The student leader's project management dashboard includes a work breakdown schedule, a time sheet and a budget tool to help manage the engagement, each of which must be completed to close out the event. Mailer templates and social media management platforms from Business Partners can be used to promote a service event or to invite others to join. V&L allows the leader to capture certain skill sets by searching, for example, for students who have Sales and Marketing Micro-Credentials - or offers him/her access to acquire this Micro Credential directly. Once the event team has been assembled, task lists are produced for each volunteer. At the end of each project, student volunteers will send a summary and pictures to the leader who will create a reflection page to close the event. Volunteer and Leadership tracks all activities, charts student progress and helps prepare comprehensive reports that will enhance college and job applications.

Service:

Volunteer and Leadership makes serving a breeze. The event is planned, and the student is invited to attend. The day prior to the event, they receive a notification reminding them of the time and location for transportation to the event. Once the task is completed, the student summarizes their experience in an easy, task-driven format and submits!



Fundraising:

Our program strives to help students raise funds for the local and global community with leadership and service opportunities in mind. Students use V&L to organize fundraising events and let others participate to show leadership in their community. Students lead fundraising with business partners; promoting organizational skills, showing leadership, and creative ways to serve. Students work on national and international fundraisers like the African Birth Certificate Fund and Salvation Army. Fundraising drives build and promote skills in areas to which our student members would not normally have access.

Education Outside Core Curriculum:

V&L delivers checklists with every event to ensure an enriched user experience with Micro-Credential skill needs built in. Students will acquire skills outside the core curriculum in our distance learning programs. Leadership and service activities reinforce skills learned through Micro-Credential achievements. Competencies like soft skills, career planning, financial literacy, project management, marketing and sales, and more are ultimately acquired in our distance learning programs, and validated through our Micro-Credentialing program. Those skills are mastered with our service opportunities, independent study, business internship and CO-OP business engagements.

Life Long Connections:

Volunteer and Leadership assists student leaders who have been in a school system for a long time to connect with a recent arrival to help them quickly acclimate to their new environment. Organizing study tables after school or providing one-on-one tutoring will immediately aid the newcomer in academia. Student leaders who are familiar with the school, businesses and community, will be instrumental in leading service opportunities that will engage and integrate recent student arrivals.

V&L focuses on recent arrivals to help them connect, acclimate, and quickly onboard their new school environment. More than 6 million high schools students move every two years; and the V&L connection will provide instant belonging, consistency and connections the first day they step into a new school.

Case Study

A proof of concept exists and has been successfully running since 2014. The founder of Volunteer and Leadership, Jacob Walker, created the Volunteer and Leadership program at St. Michael's University School (SMUS) in British Columbia, Canada. More than 200 of the 680-student population are engaged in service activities every 2 months. Over time, all students end up using the service opportunities of the club during their high school career at SMUS. Businesses, charities and students alike have found find long-term value in the program.



Maximizing Student Participation


Volunteer and Leadership has incentives built into the program to create member stickiness. The reward point system promotes daily activity like event creation, soft skill quizzes, and more. The system provides students with a way to get activities for a fee, like the micro-credentials, for points generated in the rewards system. Scholarships can be made available to those students who commit substantial time and effort in club activities. Incentives like business partner gift cards, sweepstakes entries, charity donations and more are possibilities.

Investor Need

Volunteer and Leadership has selected InteracVAULT, Inc., to design and implement the SaaS platform. The base system structure is in place allowing for short time to market with a smaller ROI timeline. InteracVAULT has 8 patented products integrated to deliver the core platform to students, teachers, higher education and businesses. Each product will require development in account generation, activity, security levels and storage in order to tailor the product to the unique needs of V&L. Of course, on all Volunteer and Leadership's IT platforms; forums and content; profile transfers; and Micro-Credential generation, advancement and storage; the student's data must be held to the upmost security and protection standards. These competencies are in the foundation stage and must be developed to apply directly to Volunteer and Leadership. Using Evolutionary Development, modules will be contained, and processes will be documented, and then rapidly deployed to production with little need for training. Our investor ask would launch the

V&L application for a practical use pilot that would serve as the incubator to grow the user numbers and provide revenue needed to expand our feature set offerings. Development, Marketing and Management staff is needed to effectively deploy these concepts.

System Changes



V&L uses a custom InteracVAULT Platform. InteracVAULT's Platform has been proven as a success in other industries, like medical, financials, and government. As seen in the images to the left and below, only minor graphical and logic routing changes would need to be made to change the current system. Below is the proposed system graphical changes to the Volunteer and Leadership program.

There are several actor dashboard views, with individual task processing and storage access for reports and credentials. These base systems are able to be repurposed for this program without having to start completely with a new development effort.

Volunteer and Leadership has unique work flow to the applications, social media forum pages, content management and membership access with interception points that must be developed and implemented. Volunteer and Leadership will perform evolutionary development in version releases that will make the system functional while incorporating sophisticated attributes as revenue gained through participation growth. Future R&D and deployment should be built into the corporate budget without need for additional investor funding.

In USA public high schools there are more than 15 million students. With this prospective client base, our SaaS price of \$60 a year at just 10% participation would yield more than \$90 million a year in base revenue. Our participation levels should expand as we capture enterprise funding from state budgets for the students, relocation budgets from private companies, and DoD budgets for dependents of military PCS. Business memberships, financial literacy product sales, and fundraising retail sales also add to the revenue collection.
